

School Board Member Resignation

On Monday March 1, 2021, Sandy Lessentine announced her intent to resign from the Lake Central School Corporation Board of Trustees. She submitted in writing that her resignation is effective March 2, 2021.

At this time and until 4:00 p.m. on March 17, 2021 the School Board is accepting letters or emails of interest for the vacant board seat. The chosen candidate will serve the remainder of Ms. Lessentine's term which expires on 12.31.22.

Interested candidates must possess the requisite qualifications provided for regularly elected board members, including:

1. At least 21 years of age, and
2. Resides in the residential district for Ms. Lessentine's seat – the Schererville District

Interested parties should submit answers to four questions as part of the application process. Questions are attached below.
