Students are expected to collaborate with teachers, counselors, and parents to create a high school plan that will not only fulfill Lake Central High School diploma requirements, but also provide a track towards college and/or career goals.

Course Requests

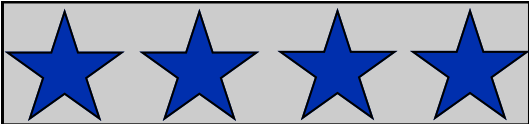
Changes in a student’s schedule will be made for the following reasons only:

- Errors made by the school in developing the schedule
- The school’s need to balance class sizes
- Medical reasons with documentation
- To correct inappropriate placement - student with a failure and needs to repeat a class or a student placed at an inappropriate level.
- To upgrade the content of the schedule - move to an advanced, Honors, or AP course, if available
- Scheduling conflicts
- Circumstances beyond those listed above will be reviewed by school counselors to determine if a change is truly needed. Counselors will also consider the input of parents, teachers, and the Advisory Team.

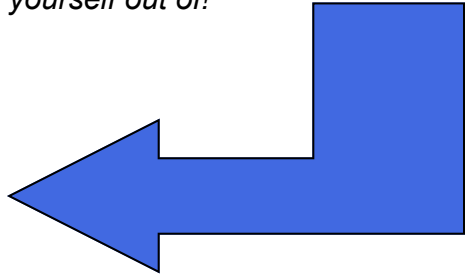
