Sports Update:



Girls Track and Field: Last night the Girls took on Clark in their final home meet of the season. Despite the loss, there were many outstanding performances. Among them were: Amanda Blevins in 1st in the hurdles followed by Maddie Maracich in 3rd. Missy Fritz took 2nd in the 100 dash. Jen Tomasic was 2nd in the mile followed by teammate Taylor Kosiek in 3rd. Elaine Werner finished in 2nd place in the 400 dash. Kayla Skertich took 2nd place for Kahler in the 800 run. Madi Mercer finished in 2nd in the 200 dash and teammate Mia Vukas was 3rd. Cali Smith took 2nd in shot put. Sarah Schoonmaker was 1st in discus and Kylie Blevins was in 3rd. In the long jump, Madi Mercer took 2nd and Missy Fritz was 3rd. Finally in the high jump, Mia Vukas took 1st place and Amanda Blevins took 2nd. The final competition will be this Thursday at the conference meet in Lowell.



Boys Track and Field: The boys' track team wrapped up its regular season record with a win over Clark last night 66 to 39. Meet highlights included:

Hurdles: Nate Oakley winning the hurdles in 17.7. Joel Arteaga was a close 4th in 18.4. Kyle Maluchnik was also sub 19. Evan Flores & Walker Hill were both in the 19's.
100 Meter Dash: Ben Villaviceacio and Caleb Brackett going 1st and 2nd (11.8 & 12.9)
1600 Run: Johnny Cortez and Zach Vollrath's 1-2 finish (5:38 & 5:45) The Kolts have several runners break 6:30!! This was one of our best years for over-all mile depth
400 Dash: Sam Richter breaking 60 seconds for the 400. Isaiah Ponce was a close 4th in 64 with Austin Immig running 67.
400 Relay: Kahler's 400 relay runners did it again---they broke 50 seconds and won---AND our placing 2 teams (and almost 3!) in front of Clark's A squad.
800 Run: Drayk Bowen was 2nd in 2:33 and his race was so close that it took three finish judges to decide a result. Zak Mohiuddin was a close 3rd in 2:37
200 Dash: The Kolts swept the 200 with Ben V. 1st in 25.6, Caleb B. 2nd in 27.2 & Noah Fallon 3rd in 27.6
1600 Relay: The 16 relay team won, yet again with a time of 4:21
Discus: Barrett 2nd in 90' 0.5" & Matthews 3rd in 84' 8.5"
Shot Put: Nate Oakley 3rd in 33'10.25"
Long Jump: Brendan Richardson 1st in 16'7.5" & Sam Richter 3rd in 14'6.5"
High Jump: Nate Oakley 1st in 5'2" and Noah Fallon 2nd in 5'1"

The Kolts finish with a record of 5 wins and 2 losses. The Kolts hope to avenge their only season losses this Thursday at the Conference Finals. Travel roster is posted outside of Coach Langlois' room. Only a limited number of athletes go.
