Kindness Club: Next meeting will be on Wednesday, October 4th @ 8:00 in the library.

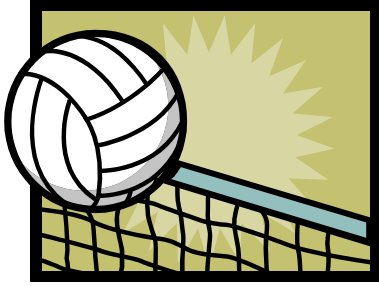
