Behind the offense of line efforts of Mike de Grado, Naseeb Mohammed, Ryan Cooper, Eric Cruise and Leo Mendez; the Colts were able to run the ball for 300 yards and 5 rushing touchdowns. Enzo DeRosa scored four touchdowns while Luke Niedy also scored once. On defense, Mike DeGrado and Eric Cruise added multiple quarterback sacks. Nick Tattini, Karson Colin, Billy Henry and Carson Crimmons all had key plays in the victory. The Colts play for the Conference Championship against Lowell at home next Wednesday, October 11, 2017 at 6:00 p.m.
