IF you have not picked up an entry form for the Saturday, March 2, Kahler Chess Tournament, please do so NOW. They are available in the office or from Mr. Langlois




If you have your \$100 Kolt cash already and would like to reserve your spot for the field trip, give it the following teachers during homeroom:
