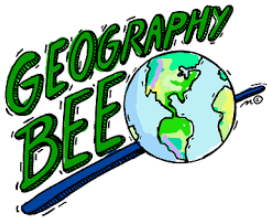

Orange: Orange you glad we're friends?

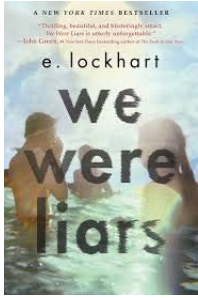

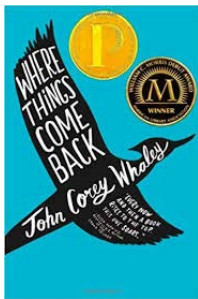
