

These books are on loan from the Lake County Public Library and must be returned in good shape the day of the book club, which is on October 23, 2020. Truly Devious is a murder mystery perfect for fall.

Here is the synopsis--

Ellingham Academy is a famous private school in Vermont for the brightest thinkers, inventors, and artists. It was founded by Albert Ellingham, an early twentieth century tycoon, who wanted to make a wonderful place full of riddles, twisting pathways, and gardens. Shortly after the school opened, his wife and daughter were kidnapped. The only real clue was a mocking riddle listing methods of murder, signed with the frightening pseudonym "Truly, Devious." Years later, Stevie Bell is set to begin her first year at Ellingham Academy, and she has an ambitious plan to solve this cold case. But the past has crawled out of its grave: *Truly Devious* makes a surprise return, and death revisits Ellingham Academy.
