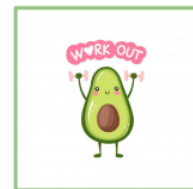

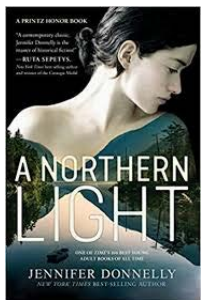
BOYS' TRACK STARTS NEXT WEEK, MONDAY, MARCH 8.
