- 1) The relay team of Morgan Maas, Saachi Parikh, Sofia Demantes and Madison Poortenga took first place in the 4X800.
- 2) The relay team of Saachi Parikh, Madison Poortenga, Madison Cowger and Gracie Jensen also took first place in the 4X400.
- 3) In the field events, Genny Cosgrove took first in discus and Hannah Arnold took third place. Moira Falli jumped to a 3rd place finish in long jump and Una Samoukovic took 3rd place in the high jump.
- 4) Una also finished in first place in the hurdles.
- 5) The Kahler girls swept the mile with Gracie Jensen in 1st, Tara Schassburger in 2nd and Moira Falli in 3rd place.
- 6) Mallory Luna finished in 2nd place in the 400 meter dash with a new personal best time of 1:08 and Madison Cowger took 3rd place.
- 7) The girls also swept the 800 meter run with Morgan Maas in 1st, Madison Poortenga in 2nd and Tara Schassburger in 3rd place.

8) Finally in the 200 meter dash, Jaclyn Baranski was 3rd place.

Peer Mentor Program Call Out


