

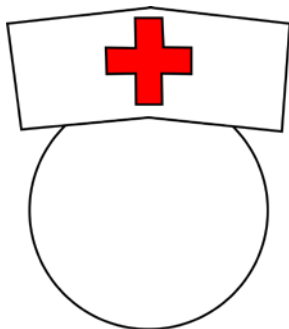
LOST AND FOUND
