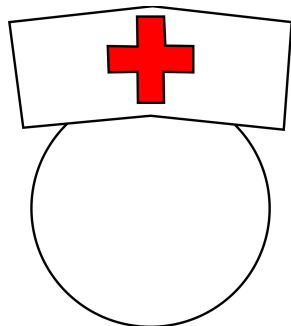
### LOST AND FOUND
