
### Lake Central Indians 2022 Baseball Camp





The January lunchtime book club read is *Dread Nation* by Justina Ireland. It is a historical fiction horror book, a zombie book set in the American Civil War era. It follows Jane McKeene, a black girl **who** was taken from her family and trained as an Attendant, trained in both weaponry and etiquette to protect the well-to-do. It's a chance for a better life for Negro girls like Jane. After all, not even being the daughter of a wealthy white Southern woman could save her from society's expectations.


### LOST AND FOUND
