




One of the Year's Best Books

The February book for lunchtime book club is Eleanor and Park by Rainbow Rowell, **Eleanor** is the new girl in town, and with her chaotic family life, her mismatched clothes and unruly red hair, she couldn't stick out more if she tried. **Park** is the boy at the back of the bus. Black T-shirts, headphones, head in a book—he thinks he's made himself invisible. But not to Eleanor... never to Eleanor.

Slowly, steadily, through late-night conversations and an ever-growing stack of mix tapes, Eleanor and Park fall for each other. They fall in love the way you do the first time, when you're young, and you feel as if you have nothing and everything to lose
