

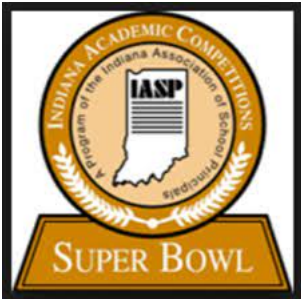

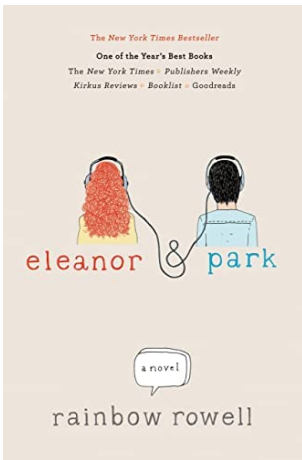

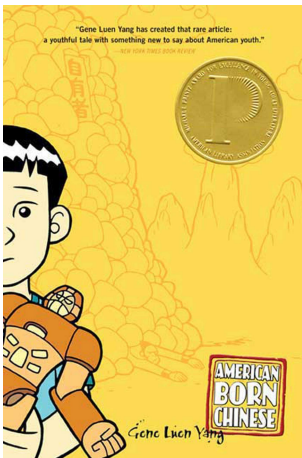
Attention Eighth Graders

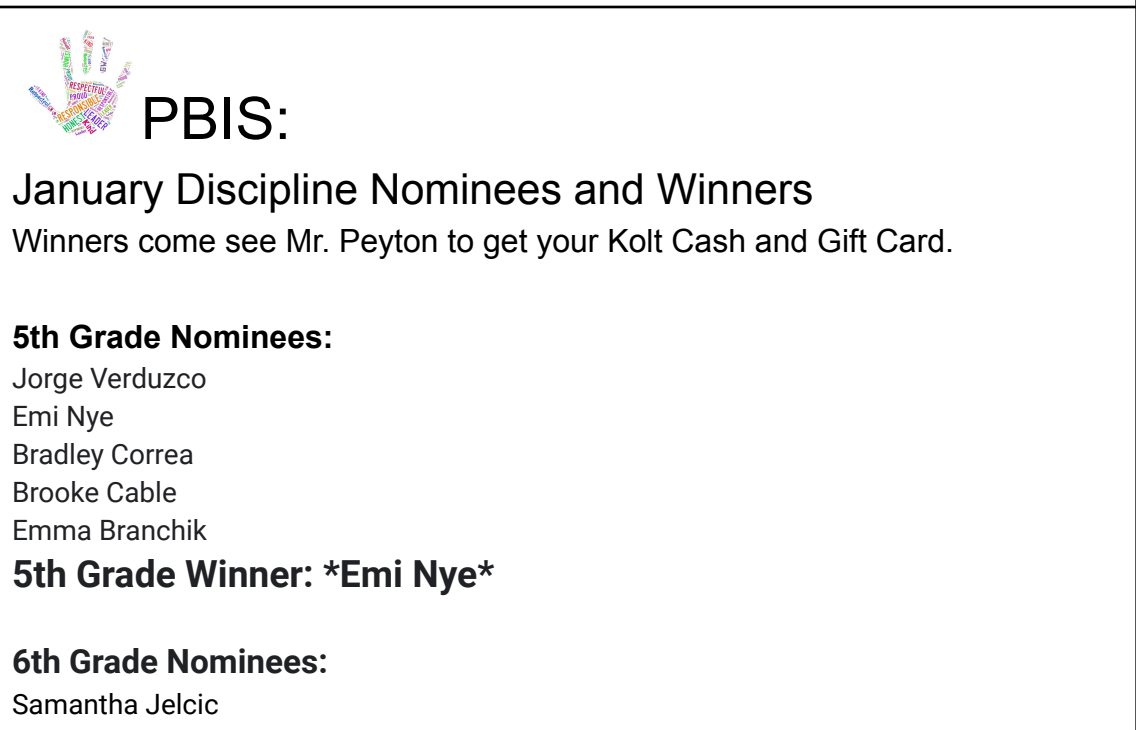



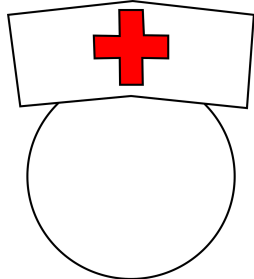
