

Attention Eighth Graders One of the Year's Best Books lew York Times - Publishers We us Reviews - Booklist - Good The February book for lunchtime book club is Eleanor and Park by Rainbow Rowell, **Eleanor** is the new girl in town, and with her chaotic family life, her mismatched clothes and unruly red hair, she couldn't stick out more if she tried. **Park** is the boy at the back of the bus. Black T-shirts, headphones, head in a book—he thinks he's made himself invisible. But not to Eleanor... never to Eleanor. eleanor Slowly, steadily, through late-night conversations and an ever-growing stack of mix tapes, Eleanor and Park fall for each other. They fall in love the way you do the first time, when you're young, and you feel as if you have nothing and everything to lose rainbow rowell If you care to read this book and come to book club, come to LBJ's classroom 143 to get your borrowed copy. Book club for the month of February is February 25. 7th grade book club is back for February! This month, the book is American Born Chinese, an awesome graphic novel. American Born Chinese tells the story of three apparently unrelated characters: Jin Wang, who moves to a new neighborhood with his family only to discover that he's the only Chinese-American student at his new school; the powerful Monkey King, subject of one of the oldest and greatest Chinese fables; and Chin-Kee, a personification of the ultimate negative Chinese stereotype, who is ruining his cousin Danny's life with his yearly visits. Their lives and stories come together with an unexpected twist in this action-packed modern fable.
