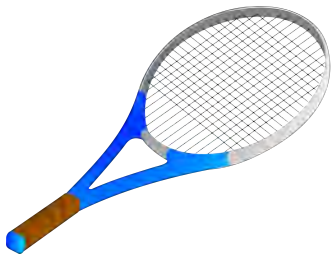

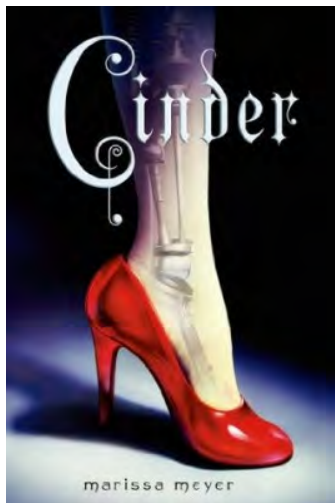
This person can juggle, has two cats *Gandalf* and *Buffy*, really enjoys board games and says,

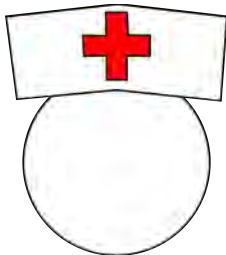
