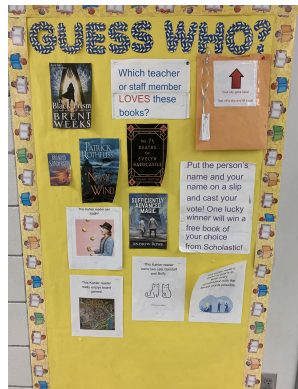
Any 6th or 7th grade students that missed the cheer call-out meeting, please pick up an informational packet from Coach Dimopoulos in room 245.

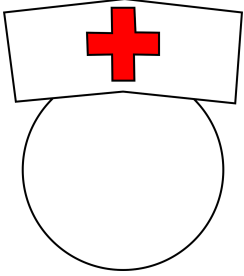
