#### The Kolts top 12 runners were:

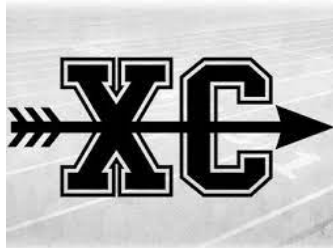

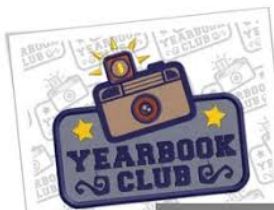

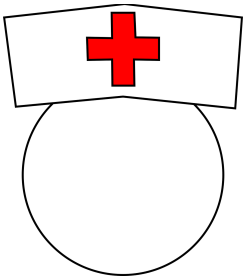
