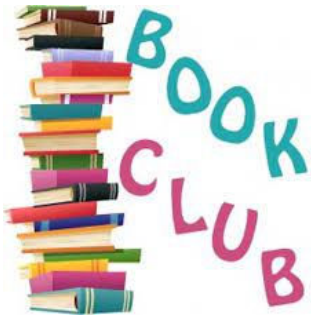

Reminder, 6th grade book club reading *Alone* will also be meeting on Friday, October 20th - Grab your lunch and meet in the library.



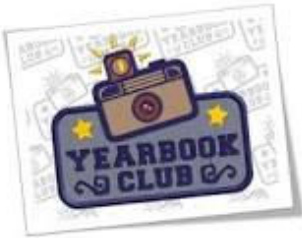

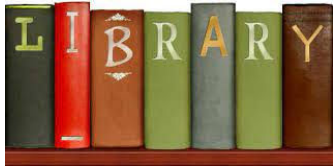
