	<b>Step 1: Sign Up</b> First, <b>read the rules</b> to make sure you know how to participate. Then you can sign up by picking up a reading log envelope from your school or at any of our branches. After you collect your sponsor money, return the envelope with <b>all of your contact information</b>
	<b>neatly filled out.</b> If we don't have your school and contact info we won't know which school to share your pledges with or how to get your prize to you!
	<b>Step 2: Rally your sponsors</b> Ask parents, friends, and neighbors to pledge 5 cents or more per book you read. For example, if a sponsor pledges 10 cents per book and you read 10 books, they should give \$1.
