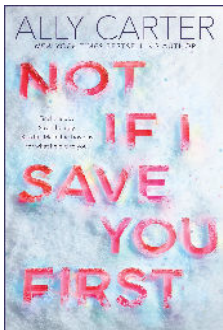

Best Buddies Friendship Walk 2024

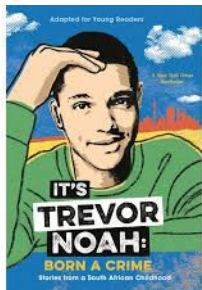
The annual Best Buddies Friendship Walk will take place on Saturday, May 11th at the Lake County Fairgrounds.

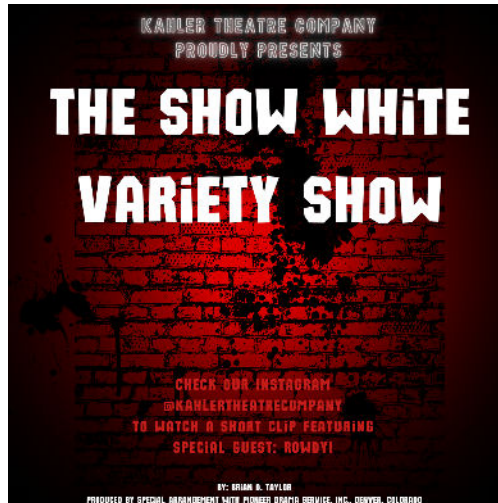
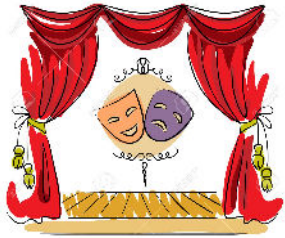
