Our boys' track and field team crushed Clark and Wilbur Wright last night---defeating both by huge margins. . The Kolts ended their regular season undefeated at eight wins and zero losses in dual meet competition.

Highlights from last night included:

- The 3200 relay team of **Calderon, Cunningham, Grentzer & Tarantino** finished the season undefeated with huge wins over Clark and Wilbur Wright
- In the 100, **Alexander and Wesley** were both under 12 seconds with Tomei at 12.9.
- In the hurdles, **Jessie** in a sub 18 won with **Ehlebrecht and Gomez** both under 19 seconds
- The high jump champ was **Alexander** in 5 foot 5 inch with **Jessie** 2nd in 5'4" ----two of the best performances throughout the conference.
- The 400 relay of **Alexander, Bond, Tuftedal, and Wesley** finished the season as undefeated with a sub 48 time
- Shot put was won by **Tuftedal** with **Zarris** 3rd
- **Calderon** was 800 champ with **Tarantino** 3rd
- The 200 champ was **Tuftedal** with **Wesley** a very, very close second. **Triston Bond** was 3rd
- **Grentzer** won the 400 in a sub 60 time with **Coughlin** 3rd. Tomei and Gomez were also both sub 70.
- The 1600 relay had both of Kahler's squads defeating Clark and Wilbur Wright's "A" squads. Team members were **Calderon, Coughlin, Grentzer, Cunningham, Perryman, Wadhah, Grady, and Tarantino**

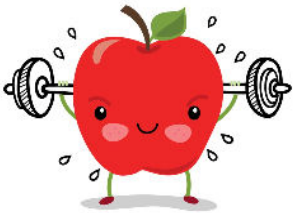

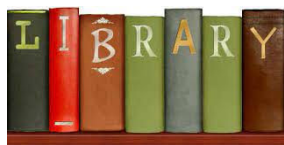
