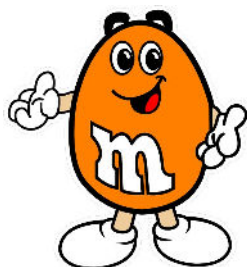

October Student Council Meeting

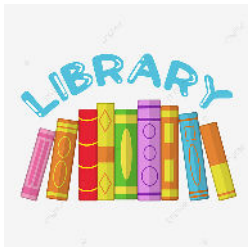
