


<u>CROSS COUNTRY:</u> Last night our boys' track team defeated Michigan City Elston

Event winners were as follows:

- 3200 relay team of Alegria, Palmer, Bluett and Arambula in 11:20
- 110 Hurdles—Kameron Jackson in 19.5. Hamilton, Capehart, and Ochman all had similar marks in B flights.
- Discus—top performer was Ryan Triezenberg in 57 9.5. Elisha Murphy was a mear half inch short of Ryan's best mark.
- Shot— Elisha Murphy in 31'1"
- High Jump—Benjamin Berwanger in 5 foot.
- 100 meter dash—Ethan Brewer won in 11.8 (the fastest opening=season 100 ever by a Kahler run).
- 1600 run—-Trever MacFarlane in 5:40
- 200 meter dash—James Brewer in 25.9
- 400 meter dash—-Evin Munoz in 59 seconds (fastest opening season 400 for a Kahler runner in over 15 years!)
- 400 relay team of Munoz, Brewer, Johnson, and Berwanger in 52 seconds
- 1600 relay team of Bravo, Munoz, Baxter, and MacFarlane in 4:37
