- In the hurdles, Ochman, Jackson, Hamblen, and Baxter all broke 20 seconds
- Trevor MacFarland's 5:25 in the mile

- MacFarland, Jackson, and Palmer sweep the long jump with leaps all in the neighborhood of 15 feet.
- Elisha Murphy was shot put champion with a throw just short of 34 feet.
- Marlow Rimpson was runner-up in discus with a throw just short of 80 feet—barely missing first place.
