



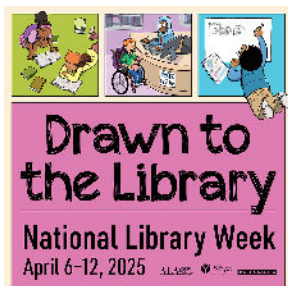


**Tuesday: Twin Day - Always double check your work!!**
