### *Lake Central Centralettes Crowned National Champions*

The Lake Central Centralettes' team recently concluded their unprecedented season by being crowned Grand National Champions at the NDA National Dance Team Championships in Orlando, Florida. This included a 1<sup>st</sup> Place finish in Varsity Jazz & Best in Category & Best Technique; a 2<sup>nd</sup> Place finish in Varsity Pom & Best Technique; and a 4<sup>th</sup> Place finish in Varsity Hip Hop.

The dancers returned home for a short week of preparation and then headed to Lafayette Jeff to compete in the IHSDTA State Championship on 3/12. Lake Central once again stood on top of the podium as the dancers earned three first place finishes: Varsity Jazz, Varsity Pom, and Varsity Hip Hop.

The storied history of Lake Central Centralettes and Coach Kevin Mathis' historic run continues. Lake Central has won every State and Regional Championship since 1995, and this year marked the 18<sup>th</sup> time our Centralettes earned a National Championship.

The hard work and dedication to their craft these young ladies and coaching staff endures cannot go unnoticed. In addition to the countless hours of preparation, the dancers celebrated with us and performed at football games and boys' basketball games; typically, late nights before their early morning competitions.

Their storied season doesn't just include a Grand National Championship, State Championship, and Regional Championship. The Centralettes competed in 7 other competitions throughout the season. In 5 of those competitions, they earned clean-

sweep victories in Varsity Jazz, Pom, and Hip Hop (*listed below*).
