

Commencement Reminders for STUDENTS (UPDATED!)

1. Class photo will be taken Tuesday, May 30 at 10:30am in the gym.
2. Rehearsal begins Friday, June 2 at 10:00am in the field house. Park in the Yellow Parking Lot and enter the building through Entrance K.
3. Expect to attend rehearsal until 12:000pm.
4. **Students will receive their family's tickets at the end of rehearsal.** Reminder - students do not need a ticket to enter the commencement ceremony, all your tickets can be used by your family.
5. DO NOT LOSE your tickets!
6. Students can dress comfortably but appropriately for rehearsal.
7. Bring to rehearsal:
 - Cap, gown, tassel
 - Any earned regalia to both rehearsal and Commencement
 - SOMETHING TO WRITE WITH (Pen or Pencil)
 - STUDENT ID
8. Appropriate dress for Commencement
 - Ladies: Light colored dress or light colored skirt with light colored blouse. It is recommended to wear a dress with pockets.
 - Gentlemen: Light colored shirt with tie, dark pants, black or brown shoes
9. For Commencement, carpool with other students or ride with your family.
10. Prior to Commencement, the parking lot will NOT open until 12:30pm.
11. Arrive at LCHS no later than 12:45pm and report directly to the field house.
12. Leave all purses/bags in your vehicle or with your family. You will not be able to walk with these items.
13. Make sure phones are silenced.
14. After reporting to the field house, go directly to your designated location and your spot in line.
15. Mortar Board (academic cap)
 - Elastic is worn at the back of the head
 - Point faces the middle of the forehead
 - Should be horizontal (parallel) to the floor
 - Caps cannot be decorated. If decorated, all decorations will be taken off prior to the Commencement or you will be issued a new cap.
16. Tassel – The tassel is worn on the front-right side of the mortar board and then placed on the front-left after the diploma is received. Students will receive instructions from Mr. Begley regarding when to move the tassel over.
17. Commencement will begin promptly at 2:00pm.

Your parents, the administration, faculty, and staff have spent a tremendous amount of time and effort planning and organizing your graduation ceremony. Please behave in a respectful and dignified manner to ensure a positive experience for all those in attendance.

Noisemakers (including air horns, cow bells, and whistles), beach balls, balloons, and other related items are not permitted.
