**JUDGING** ...**ONLY** participants, judges, and Science Fair personnel will be permitted in the cafeteria. Snacks will be provided for the students.

10:45 a.m. - 11:45 a.m.

**PUBLIC EXHIBITION** ...All are invited to attend. Students are to stay with their projects to explain them to visitors.

11:45 a.m. - 12:00 p.m.

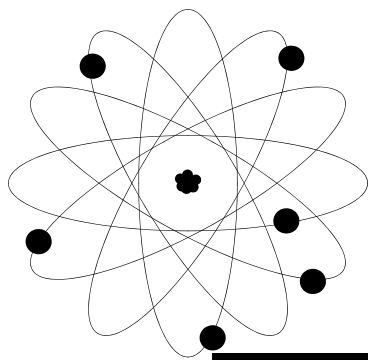

## Lake Central Science Fair

### FRIDAY — APRIL 1, 2016

SET-UP PROJECTS in the Lake Central High School Cafeteria  
from 5:00 - 6:00 p.m.

1. All projects must stand up by themselves. DO NOT ask for tape or tacks.
2. Remove all boxes and sacks.
3. If you need an extension cord, you must BRING YOUR OWN!
4. Be sure to check the guidelines for "Allowed" items at the fair.

### SATURDAY — APRIL 2, 2016

ALL students must be beside their projects no later than 8:30 a.m.  
Enter through the front door of the high school and go to the cafeteria.  
Parents are allowed in the fair AFTER 10:45.

1. **Only participants are allowed** in the fair during judging. Siblings and friends are not allowed.
2. Look presentable by dressing appropriately.
3. **Only provided** snacks and drinks will be allowed in the FAIR.
4. Be courteous during judging. Offer the judges your seat.
5. There will be **NO ROAMING AROUND** while waiting to be judged or after judging.
6. If you choose to bring personal electronic devices to the science fair, they are the participant's responsibility. The Science Fair Committee is not responsible for any damage or loss that may occur. You are encouraged to bring a book with you to the fair.
7. All students who have projects are to be by their projects to answer questions from visitors between 10:45 - 11:45 a.m.
8. Visitors may view the **FAIR** between 10:45 – 11:45 a.m.
9. Awards will be presented at 11:45 a.m.
10. All projects are to be taken down promptly after the awards presentation., and taken home on SCIENCE FAIR SATURDAY.
11. Every participant will receive a certificate.
