Community

Lake Central High School (LCHS) is located in St. John, Indiana and serves the "Tri-town Area" which includes the communities of Dyer, Schererville, and St. John, Indiana.

The Tri-town covers an area of 32 square miles and has over 60,000 diverse residents. It is situated in the northwest corner of Indiana only 35 short miles southeast of Chicago, IL and 158 miles northwest of Indianapolis, IN.

The district's proximity to large metropolitan areas, along with settings ranging from suburban to rural, has caused **continued growth** and **desirability** in the community.

The Lake Central Community School district is made up of six elementary schools (K-4), three middle schools (5-8), and one high school (9-12). Approximately 10,000 **culturally, academically, and economically diverse** students are served in an educationally **rigorous** and **challenging** atmosphere.

As a result of rapid community growth and advances in educational technology, LCHS is in the third and final stage of **significant renovation** on the current school grounds. A new three-story, state of the art, **Academic Wing** is already occupied and completion for the entire project is expected during the 2015-2016 school year.

Lake Central High School has been **fully accredited by AdvanceED** since opening its doors in 1966. The course offerings available to LCHS students are among the most **abundant** and **rigorous** in the state.

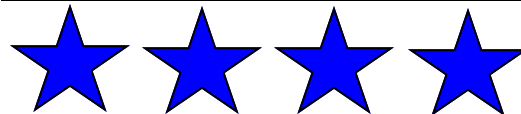

Faculty

All Lake Central High School certified staff are considered **"Highly Qualified"** by the State of Indiana and hold a **minimum** of a bachelor's degree in their respective fields of study. 53% percent of certified personnel **hold a master's degree or higher**. Many are qualified, and hold positions, as college/university faculty. Also, many of the faculty and staff are Lake Central High School alumni, continuing the pride, honor, and tradition of the tribe!

Schedule

Lake Central High School's bell schedule is organized on a block 8-matrix. The maximum course load is seven credits per semester and students have the opportunity to earn 14 total credits per school year. Each class period is 90 minutes in length. Students attend all periods on alternating days. One through four meet on "Blue Days" and periods five through seven on "White Days." The last 90 minutes of White days allows for the rotation of periods one through seven. With this schedule, classes meet an additional 12 times a year and increases the instructional time by 1080 minutes per year.



Advanced Placement (AP)

Lake Central High School offers **20** College Board "curriculum-approved" **Advanced Placement** courses.

During the May 2015 test administration:

- **1,109 TOTAL AP EXAMS ADMINISTERED**
- **63.1% resulted in a qualifying score of a 3 or higher**
- **29% of all students in the class of 2015 earned a qualifying score (3 or higher)**
- **80 students were AP Scholars** (3.07 avg. score on 3 or more exams)
- **26 students were AP Scholars with Honor** (3.62 avg. score.)
- **26 students were AP Scholars with Distinction** (4.10 avg. score.)
- **3 students were named National AP Scholars** with an average score of 4.34 on 3 or more exams!

ACT EPAS

Lake Central Community Schools participates in ACT's **EPAS® Educational Planning and Assessment System**. The EPAS system provides a longitudinal, systematic approach to educational and career planning, assessment, instructional support, and evaluation. The system focuses on the integrated, higher-order thinking skills that are important for **success**.

CLASS RANK AND GRADUATION HONORS

On August 17, 2009, the Lake Central School Board adopted a policy to **eliminate class rank from the high school transcript**. Board Policy 007.22 took effect with the graduating class of 2012. There **will no longer be a class valedictorian and salutatorian**. The following honor groups will be in place.

Distinguished Honors at Graduation

Grade point average is based on a 4.0 scale. A weighted factor is used for Honors and Advanced Placement classes resulting in an individual's GPA exceeding a 4.0. Three distinct classifications will be recognized. To qualify for any of these distinctions, individuals will need a minimum of 47 credits at the end of the 8th semester.

- **Summa Cum Laude**, "With highest honor" will be individuals at and above a GPA of 4.5
- **Magna Cum Laude**, "With great honor" will be individuals with a GPA between 4.2500 and 4.4999
- **Cum Laude**, "With honor" will be individuals with a GPA between 4.000 and 4.2499.
