COVID-19 Prevention Tip: The [CDC](#) shares the following dos and don'ts when selecting a mask.

Do choose masks that:

- Have two or more layers of washable, breathable fabric
- Completely cover your nose and mouth
- Fit snugly against the sides of your face and don't have gaps

Don't choose masks that:

- Are made of fabric that makes it hard to breathe
- Have exhalation valves or vents, which allow virus particles to escape
- Are intended for healthcare workers, including N95 respirators or surgical masks

This year, the unused/canceled exam fee is waived for students who may later decide not to test. All students who currently plan to take AP exams should register now because the \$45 per exam late order fee still applies this year for exams ordered after October 30.
