The information will be published on January 27, 2021 and will have three parts. The information will be accessible through an email using School Messenger and the information will be posted on the LCHS website (<https://lake-central.lcsc.us/>) on January 27, 2021. The three parts to the information will be broken down as follows:

Part I: Principal Welcome Message

An informational video and presentation from the LCHS principal on making the transition from middle school to high school, important information, important dates (to include summer pool and PE information), and resources to make your transition to high school successful.

Part II: Freshman Course Selection Guide

The Freshman Course Selection Guide will contain descriptions for all the academic courses freshmen students can take. In addition, several of the teachers have made videos and provided additional information that describe the classes in greater detail. A QR code will be provided in the description in order to access the video and/or class information.

Part III: Information on Clubs and Organizations

We will provide a listing with QR codes that describe the different clubs and organizations we have at LCHS. We encourage all our students to get involved in different activities while in high school. By reviewing the list and reviewing the materials, our incoming freshmen may be able to find a club that they would like to join.

As we get closer to the start of the school year (August 10, 2021) and assuming COVID restrictions relax, we will have opportunities for incoming freshmen and their parents to tour the campus and become familiar with the school building.
