**Lake Central High School (LCHS) is a vibrant, student-centered school for grades 9-12. The school features a proud tradition of success in academics, career and technical education, the arts, and athletics.**

LCHS serves the “Tri-town” communities of Dyer, Schererville, and St. John, Indiana. This area includes 32 square miles and more than 60,000 diverse residents. Situated in the northwest corner of Indiana, Tri-town is only 35 miles southeast of Chicago, Illinois, and 158 miles northwest of Indianapolis.

# INSIDE THE CLASSROOM



## COURSES

LCHS has been fully accredited by the state of Indiana since opening its doors in 1966. The course offerings for students are among the most abundant and rigorous in the state with:

- 200+ course options
- 23 Advanced Placement (AP courses)
- 40 dual credit courses
- 63 career and technical education courses
- 18 honors/advanced courses

Students take 7 courses in a semester plus an extra 90 minute period called Pathways to Excellence (PtE). The first 30 minutes of PtE students have various college/career seminars as well as social/emotional instructional seminars. The remaining 60 minutes is available for students to receive academic assistance and study.

## SCHEDULE

The students follow a block schedule of Blue Days and White Days. Each day covers four class periods which meet for ninety minutes. PtE is permanently on White Days during 6th period.

- Blue Day  
Periods 1, 2, 3, 4
- White Day  
Periods 5, 6, 7, 8

## FACULTY

LCHS certified staff are considered “Highly Effective” by the State of Indiana and hold a minimum of a bachelor’s degree in their respective fields of study. More than half of the certified personnel hold a master’s degree or higher, and several hold positions as college/university faculty. Additionally, many teachers are alumni, continuing the tradition of excellence of Pride!

## GRADING AND CLASS RANK

Grade point average (GPA) is based on a 4.0 scale. A weighted factor is used for honors and advanced placement classes, which results in a student’s GPA exceeding a 4.0.

Average percentages of the last 5 years


- 90% earned a Core 40 diploma or higher
