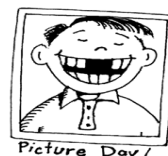


Random Acts of Kindness

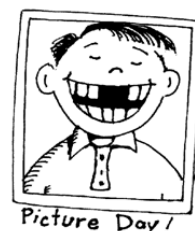
Personal Birthday Invitations
