Dismissal Procedures

Please read this information that will help us maintain a safe and smooth dismissal each day.

- Enter through the WEST entrance and follow the line of cars.
- STAY OFF YOUR CELL PHONE while in the pick-up line. If you need to be on your phone, please pull over into a parking space and then rejoin the line once you have completed your call.
- Pay attention to staff. When they are loading cars, they may need to walk in front of your vehicle.
- Please do not get out of your vehicle or shout for your child to come to you. We will always walk your child directly to your car.
- Once you pull forward, put your car in park and remain in that spot until your vehicle is loaded. We have some parents creeping forward while we are still loading vehicles.
- We require students to hold a staff member's hand when walking to your vehicle. If you see your child resisting, please remind them it is required for their safety.
- We are having difficulty with some children not paying attention while walking down the sidewalk. Please help us remind them it is their responsibility to walk quietly, pay attention, and listen for their name to be called. I have instructed staff not to proceed down the sidewalk unless all children are paying attention.
- We have more car riders this year than in prior years. In order to accommodate vehicles, we will load in two rounds. We will walk students down to the end of the sidewalk and complete one pass. Then we will have the remaining students return to the front entrance and have the remaining cars pull all the way forward to the crosswalk before loading the second round of vehicles. If you are in the second round, please pull all the way forward.
- I strongly encourage you to allow your children to ride the bus. It is a very safe option.

Please understand that our primary responsibility at dismissal is to keep the children and staff safe. If everyone follows these safety procedures, we will be able to continue to provide quality service to our families. Thank you for your support!!
