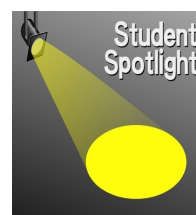


Principal for the Hour

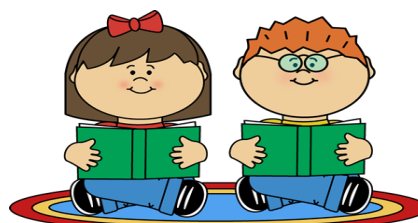
First Grade: Yellow

Friday, April 12—"Curl Up with a Good Book" -

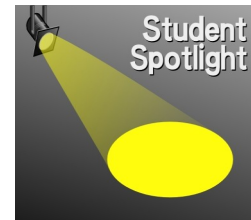
Each class will curl up and read. Children may wear pajamas and bring a small stuffed animal that can fit in their backpack.
