# Personal Birthday Invitations

To avoid embarrassment/hurt feelings, approval from the teacher must be obtained prior to distributing invitations. Invitations must be given to all the boys, or all the girls, or the entire class. The school cannot provide you with student addresses or phone numbers.

## **Recess**

Weather permitting children will go outside for recess. Flip flops, shoes that do not protect the toes, shoes with wheels, and high soled clogs are not safe to wear to school. For safety reasons, any student wearing this type of footwear will not be allowed to go on the playground equipment. Please help us keep your children safe.

**Student Arrival Time**—Buses and other students should arrive at 8:00 AM. Student arrival time is 7:50 AM for those having breakfast in the cafeteria. Supervision of students is not available until 7:55 AM. Students should be seated in their classrooms when the tardy bell rings at 8:10 AM.

**Student Dismissal Time**—Dismissal of bus riders starts at 2:40 PM. Car riders are dismissed **after** buses, approximately 2:50 PM.

# End of Day Dismissal

Please help us keep your children safe. Everything went very well the first week. Thanks for your support!! Just a reminder, if you wish to pick up your child, a note must be sent to your child's teacher. If a child who normally rides the bus is being picked up after school, a note should be sent to school. If someone other than the parent or guardian is to pick up your child, we must have a note signed by the parent stating that they have been given permission. If the need to pick up your child arises AFTER your child has left for school, you MUST call the office. If there is no note or phone call, your child will be sent home on the bus. Students riding home in cars will be dismissed after the bus riders. Our parking lot is very congested during afternoon dismissal. We encourage all parents to allow their children to ride the bus home.

Students are considered Tardy if they are NOT IN THEIR CLASSROOMS by 8:10 AM. Students that are late <u>should be accompa-</u> <u>nied by an adult</u> to sign them in at the front office.	If your child will be absent for any reason, please call the office at (219) 322-1185 to report their absence.
