### **Kindergarten Enrollment**

**Kindergarten enrollment for 2021-2022 school year will be available on-line from March 15-19.**

To be eligible for Kindergarten, your child must be 5 years old on or before August 1, 2021 and legally reside within the Lake Central School Corporation boundaries. The following documents WILL BE required: child's original legal birth certificate (no hospital copy), parents valid Indiana Driver's License or State ID with current address, two proofs of residency (i.e., home ownership papers or rental agreement, and one current utility bill verifying address), and in the case of a divorce or separation, a copy of the custody papers. Children that are 5 years old between Aug. 2 - Oct. 1, 2021 may appeal for early entrance to Kindergarten by contacting the office. **Documentation MUST be submitted before enrollment is complete.**

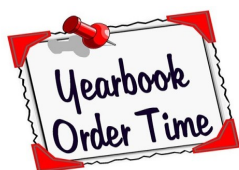
### **Gym Class**
