## End of Day Dismissal

Please help us keep your children safe. Everything went very well the first week. Thanks for your support!! Just a reminder, if you wish to have your child be a car rider, a note must be sent to your child's teacher. If a child who normally rides the bus is being picked up after school, a note should be sent to school. If someone other than the parent or guardian is to pick up your child, we must have a note signed by the parent stating that they have been given permission. If the need to pick up your child arises AFTER your child has left for school, you MUST call the office. If there is no note or phone call, your child will be sent home on the bus. Students riding home in cars will be dismissed during bus dismissal. Car rider parents, please have your child's first and last name visible on your passenger side window for staff to easily see at dismissal. Our parking lot is very congested during afternoon dismissal. Please follow the instructions of the dismissal personnel.

Students are considered Tardy if they are NOT IN THEIR CLASSROOMS by 8:10 AM. Students that are late <u>should be accompa-</u> <u>nied by an adult</u> to sign them in at the front office.
