Dismissal

Following are details about dismissal times and procedures:

It is very important that car rider parents **do not arrive prior to 2:40** so traffic doesn't back up onto 81st Ave. Please remain in your vehicle, pull up and out of the line if you need to help your child with their seatbelt. **If the need to pick up your child arises AFTER your child has left for school, you MUST call the office BEFORE 1:30pm.**
