<u>Fair Haven</u>

The State of Indiana passed legislation requiring school districts to provide personal safety education to students in K-12. Lake Central has partnered with the staff at Fair Haven who will present the personal safety program, "Think First and Stay Safe", the week of November 13-17 to Bibich Elementary students. This program will be presented in person to the students in their classrooms. If your child attended Bibich last year, they participated in this curriculum. This child safety curriculum is research-based and has been scientifically evaluated and proven to help children stay safe. The "Think First & Stay Safe" program teaches students the importance of treating themselves and one another with kindness and respect. Through developmentally appropriate lesson plans, students learn about healthy relationships and personal boundaries. These interactive lessons allow children to better recognize appropriate vs. inappropriate behaviors and use their critical thinking skills to make safe and healthy choices. The program provides a balanced perspective and keeps students engaged in learning vital safety strategies. Students are continually reassured that most people are kind, safe, and can be counted on should the need for help arise. They learn to identify trusted adults in their lives and are encouraged to reach out and speak when needed.
