Girls Schedule (Enter at Door A):

- 5:30-6:00 Meet Teacher in classroom
- 6:00 - 6:15 Invited to self-tour the playground and hallways
- 6:15-6:30 Meet Principals and PTO Board in Cafe

Since teacher assignments will not yet be available in Skyward, our school will post physical lists throughout the building the night of the event.

We invite you to use this time to show your child where his/her classroom will be, learn about what experiences your child will have in kindergarten, and enjoy a treat in our café - compliments of the Kolling PTO.

Parents are asked to bring all school supplies to this event so that children will have a lighter load on the first day. Please put all supplies in a large paper bag with your child's name on the bag. Small supplies should not be labeled.

This opportunity is being offered to kindergarten students only as a means to ease the anxiety of starting school for the first time. In order for kindergarteners and parents to get the most out of the evening, we strongly encourage families to arrange for a babysitter for young, non-kindergarten children when possible.

For safety reasons, parents will not be permitted to walk children to classrooms on the first student day or any other day of school. For this reason, we highly encourage you to participate in this event.

Dear Newly Enrolled Parent/Student:

Welcome to the Lake Central School System! We are happy that you have entrusted us to educate your child and we look forward to having him/her with us.

Your student is officially enrolled for the 2021-22 school year. The information you provided during the ENROLLMENT PROCESS reserved a spot for him/her in the fall. The process will be complete once you complete the ONLINE REGISTRATION in late July along with the rest of our student body.

What you can expect:

If you are a new family to the Lake Central School District, Skyward Family AccessLogin ID and temporary password will be emailed to you by mid-July. This email will also have instructions on how to set up your account, how to officially “online register” and how you will use the system to access your child’s grades, report cards and student information throughout their time in the Lake Central School System. If you do not receive a code by July 25th, please go to www.lcsc.us and click on the Skyward Link. Click the “forgot password link” and enter the email address you enrolled your child with and the system will email your login and a temporary password. You may also email your child’s name and school to skywardaccess@lcscmail.com and someone will send you an email with your activation information.

If you already have a Skyward Family Access account, the newly enrolled student has been added to that account. If you do not see him/her when you login, please email skywardaccess@lcscmail.com so we can resolve that for you.

Remember, your child is only enrolled at this point; you must go through online registration to complete the process.

Date: June 22, 2021

This fall your child will be coming to a Lake Central elementary school for the first time. A kindergartener's anxiety (and yours) may be high as formal education begins. We have found that riding the bus prior to the first day can significantly reduce a child's apprehension regarding riding the bus to school, and we strongly encourage all families to participate. Additionally, our drivers really like the opportunity to introduce themselves to their new riders and their parents. Each kindergarten student will be allowed to ride the school bus with his/her parent or another adult the day before the start of the regular school year. Only students accompanied by an adult will be allowed to ride the bus. Brothers or sisters under school age will not be allowed to participate in the school bus orientation due to Child Safety restraint laws. **Please be advised that anyone that rides that morning, masks will be mandatory.**

This opportunity for the 2021-22 school-year will begin with the buses **leaving the Transportation Center at 10:00 a.m. on Monday, August 9, 2021** to start picking up kindergartners. If you and your child are planning on participating in this orientation program please be at your bus stop at 10:00 to ensure that your child does not miss the bus. If you are unsure of your stop please call the Transportation Department @ 219-365-3141. Remember that the buses are running their entire route and it depends on where you are located on that route as to what time your actual pick up time will be.

All kindergarten and adult riders will arrive at their respective school and will be shown the arrival location of their bus and the entrance to the school the child will be using on his/her first day of school.

Currently the transportation routes are being finalized for the 2021-22 school-year. By Monday, August 2nd you will be able to obtain information on your specific route at the following web address:
