Pick Up & Drop Off Procedures

If you wish to pick up your child from school early, please send a note to school with your student (bring to the office before the bell rings in the morning). Your child will be waiting in the office for you at the time you indicate. Please come in and sign your student out. All students should be picked up and dropped off by Door J on the south side of the building. **Doors do not open until 8:15 AM.**

If your student is absent, please contact the Attendance Secretary before 10:00 AM. For student safety, automated messages/emails will be sent to parents who have not reported their student absent. Messages can be left 24/7 at 219-365-9203 at extension 7100.

Thanks for your help when dropping your children off by door J on the south side; however, please be mindful of the following issues: (1) please make sure that you remain in the car line and do not allow your child to exit the vehicle until they are motioned out by a staff member. (2) If you are parking your car, please use a proper parking spot, do not drive in-between the orange cones, and do not pull out into oncoming traffic if you are parked in the front row. (3) The handicapped parking spots are needed for our students with disabilities and we appreciate your help in keeping those spots available. (4) When escorting your child to door J, please use the cross-walk located by the three orange cones. Thank you for your help in this matter!

Medication

The Lake Central School Board policy requires ALL medication to be kept in the nurse's office in the original container. Medications MUST be delivered and picked up from school by a parent.

For Grades K-12:

The student's <u>username</u> is their Full Student Gmail Address. (i.e. JRSmith@lcstudents.com) (You can access this in Skyward, or contact your child's teacher)

The student's <u>password</u> is their first initial last initial then Student ID Number (i.e. JS2890001) Be sure the initials are typed with CAPITAL LETTERS. Do not use spaces.

to create a parent account.


To create a Parent Account:

Be sure your child has already logged in once and accepted their courses.

First, Go to: https://lakecentral.instructure.com Log in using YOUR CHILD's login information.

From your CHILD's Dashboard,

- 1. Go to "Account" (on left panel)
- 2. Then click on "Settings".
- 3. On the "Settings" screen, click on "Pair with Observer" (right side panel).
- 4. A box will open with a 24-hour Code. COPY THIS CODE.
- 5. Go back to "Account" on the left, then LOGOUT.



You should return to the Canvas Login page. Click on the link to create a Parent account. Enter your information, with an email and password that is unique to YOU. (**Do not use your child's login information.**) Enter the code you copied from above. Click on the "terms of use" box, then click "Start Participating".


After creating your parent account for your first child following the directions above,
